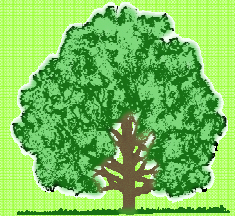

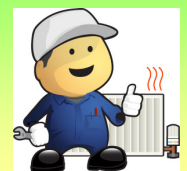


CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY ACTION

CHURCH HEATING

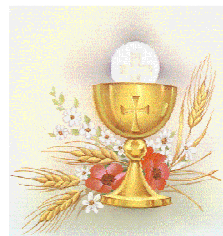
