ADORATION



Please just continue to pray as we still have a long way to go but with God's help, I feel we will get there.</p>	<p>All Confirmation Candidates and their families are invited to a small celebration after Mass next Saturday 2nd July, in the church centre. There will be refreshments and a celebration cake, so please do come along if you can !</p> <div style="text-align: center;"></div>	<p>A new translation ~ why do we need one ? Firstly, the translation made in the early 1970s was done very quickly to enable people to use English at Mass. In the process, some of the richness of the original Latin prayers was, quite literally, 'lost in translation'. It became clear that a further translation was needed, which would keep the original words, meaning and style of the Latin as far as possible, and would 'bring out' the Biblical language and imagery in the prayers of the Mass. Secondly, the new translation also means a new edition of the Missal which will include some texts added since the 1970s e.g. additional Eucharistic Prayers, some new Masses for the Blessed Virgin Mary and Masses for new Feasts of Saints added by the Church to the liturgical calendar.</p>
