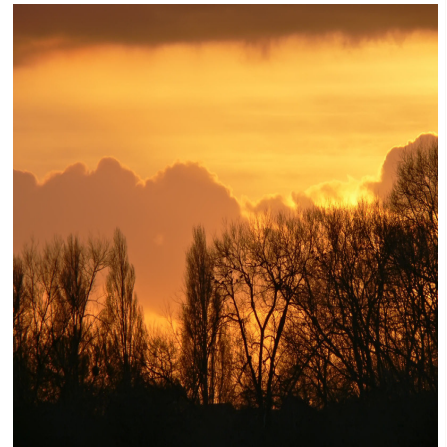

the coin, Jesus told them

was due the emperor, but

to pay more attention to
what belonged to God.
Sometimes we can get into
debates similar to the one
Jesus had with the chief
priests and Pharisees.
People often wear us down
with their relentless
arguing. We would do well
to remember and try to
imitate Jesus' simple and
straightforward
response.
